She's very uncomfortable. 12:15pm 3/4cc Banamine, I took her from the little pasture up to the creep feeder. When I took her halter off she rolled and kicked several times, I think the shot was stinging her, then she laid on her side for a while with her neck stretched out. I went in and rubbed her neck and she kushed properly. 1:30pm she's nibbling on hay. 1:30pm gave her 10oz water with 3 teaspoons yogurt. 6:15pm 12 oz water 10:30pm 12 oz water
